Squamish Off-Road Cycling Association Notes to the Financial Statements For the nine months ended September 30, 2024

1. Accounting policies

These financial statements reflect accrual accounting. SORCA has adopted the deferral method for revenue recognition of contributions.

2. Cash and cash equivalents

As at September 30, 2024, the cash balance included \$10,000 (2023 - \$30,000) in grant funds which are restricted in use and recognized as deferred revenue. See Note 3 for further details. \$48,000 (2023 - \$0) also included in the September 30, 2024 cash balance has been internally restricted for trail maintenance projects. See Note 4 for further details.

3. Deferred revenue & contributions

As at September 30, 2024, deferred revenue & contributions includes \$10,000 (2023 - \$30,000) of unearned grant funding which is externally restricted in use for specific programs. The breakdown of externally restricted grant funding is as follows:

4. Restricted funds

As at September 30, 2024, \$48,000 (2023 - \$0) of net assets are restricted in use. At the September 9, 2024 Board meeting, the Board approved to internally restrict \$20,000 for the Squamish Nation Youth Mountain Bike Program related expenses in the upcoming year and \$28,000 towards the Stl'Ihalem Sintl, Meadow of the Grizzly & Nelson trail improvements.

5. Remuneration

In fiscal 2024 SORCA paid annual remuneration in excess of \$75,000 to two individuals including employees of the society and contractors. Total remuneration paid to these individuals was \$168,868.

6. Trail work contractors

In fiscal 2024 SORCA contracted trail work totaling \$258,903, which included the following projects: SORCA Mountain Bike Youth Skills Park, Casino Jumps/Dirt Wizards Jump Park Association, Stl'lhalem Sintl'/ Pseudo Parking Lot and trailhead improvements, Pseudo 3 bridge rebuild, and Manboobs upgrades.
