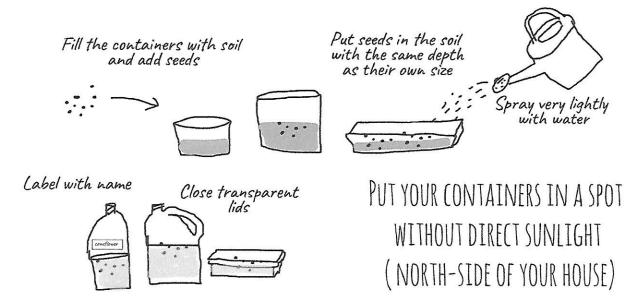


Most native plant seeds can be planted directly into the soil. For better results it is recommended to use a container that protects the seeds from birds, runoff etc.

For container seeding, follow the steps below or join us at our yearly winter seeding workshop.

If you keep a lid on the plants, you will hardly need to water. Without the lid, keep the soil lightly moisturized at all times, but protect from heavy rainfall.

It can takes weeks to months before the plants appear!



PLANT IN SPRING Plant before summer heat. Water seedlings regularly.

PLANT IN FALL Plant after summer heat. Water only once or twice after planting.
