Landscape Architects vs. Landscape Contractor

If you are looking for a bespoke design where details matter, choose a landscape architect. Landscape architects are licensed professionals with a degree in landscape architecture, who have satisfied the apprenticeship requirement under a landscape architect to learn the craft, and have passed a state-sponsored licensing exam. Plus, we are required to keep up with annual Continuing Education classes that keep us at the leading edge of new methodologies and trends.

By contrast, landscape contractors or design-build firms do not have to have licensed professionals on staff. In fact, they are not permitted to. They might get you a set of drawings faster with a lower design fee, but you get whatever the contractor you are working with is familiar with designing. That means your outdoor space will look like everyone else's in the neighborhood. Oh, and those low design fees often lead to high construction costs because you can't take the design and get competitive bids from other contractors like you can with us.

Did you know landscape architects must take an oath to put the "health, safety, and welfare" of our clients first? That primary objective protects you throughout the entire process, from the first pencil on the page to the last blade of grass. We ensure your project's design best meets your unique needs, as opposed to steering it towards in-house construction services.

Understanding your vision

Investigating your site

Before we can begin designing, we need to do our research, including understanding any zoning restrictions on your property and investigating the existing site conditions.



Construction Drawings

Once you choose a Schematic Design to move forward with, we'll start finalizing all the details that make it unique. The final product in this stage is a set of construction drawings that allow us to help you get competitive bids from contractors and are used to get necessary permits.



Agreeing to work together

This is when our formal work together starts. We'll send you a proposal and contract outlining our services, expected deliverables, and fees.



Schematic Design

This is the fun part! In this stage, we'll start sketching our ideas for your property. You will begin seeing your outdoor oasis take shape through sketches, precedent imagery, and early site plans.



Construction Administration
