LNG EXPANSION IN LOUISIANA



Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) fracked gas that has been compressed into a liquid form. This process is super dirty, producing as much or more emissions than coal. In 2022, **the U.S. became top EXPORTER of LNG** in the world.

Currently over 12 more LNG projects are proposed for LA [5 in Southeast LA and 7 in Southwest LA] with **the biggest LNG terminal in the world being built an hour south of NOLA.**

PETROCHEMICAL BUILD-OUT

From 1936 - 2016, **Louisiana's Industrial Tax Exemption Program (ITEP)** offered 100% property tax exemption for industrial manufacturers, incentivizing over 150 oil and petrochem facilities to build in Cancer Alley.

The **Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality [LDEQ]** continues to grant permits to petrochem facilities located within miles of Black communities. However, the EPA has taken action to hold LDEQ accountable for environmental racism. Pressure the state to put a full stop moratorium on

CARBON WASTE INJECTION / CARBON CAPTURE & STORAGE

Carbon capture is a scheme to capture carbon dioxide from industry emissions and inject it into empty / abandoned oil and gas wells all over Louisiana. Burying this waste underground is not proven to work, could contaminate groundwater and will affect subsidence & flooding.

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GULF OF MEXICO OIL DRILLING LEASES

The Gulf of Mexico already supplies over 97% of the U.S.'s offshore oil and gas production.

Demand the **Department of Interior & Bureau of Ocean & Energy Management** release a 5 year plan that excludes new lease sales & phases out oil/gas production on public lands & waters by 2035 | @healthygulf
