GEORGE'S AT THE COVE

Indulge in a sensory experience on the ocean terrace of George's at the Cove, where you can see and feel the beauty of La Jolla's epic scenery. Since 1984, locals have flocked to this institution for lunch, happy hour and dinner, indulging in local swordfish, Wild Isles salmon and fish tacos among the coastal breeze and stellar sunsets. georgesatthecove.com

VALLE

Executive chef Roberto Alcocer showcases the flavors and traditions of Mexico's Baja California region at the Michelin-starred Valle using seasonal ingredients sourced from both sides of the border. Located adjacent to Mission Pacific Beach Resort in Oceanside, the restaurant's wraparound patio is the perfect place to indulge in the chef's seasonal eight-course tasting menu while taking in beachfront views of the nearby Oceanside Pier. valleoceanside.com

A.R. VALENTIEN

Following a refresh of its kitchen, A.R. Valentien welcomes guests to savor chef Kelli Crosson's ever-changing seasonal menu. Overlooking the 18th hole of the iconic Torrey Pines Golf Course, the restaurant provides an inviting atmosphere highlighted by its scenic covered patio. DOCKSIDE 1953

Tucked within the Bahia Resort Hotel, Dockside 1953 pairs picturesque views with fine dining favorites. While docked boats sway in the distance, settle in under the covered trellis as you savor tender blackened tuna steak or the 14-ounce apple cider-brined pork chop. After your meal, toast to a night well-spent over smoked Old Fashioneds around the fire pit overlooking Mission Bay. bahiahotel.com/dockside-1953

SERÉA COASTAL CUISINE

With warmer days ahead, reserve a table at Seréa at the historic Hotel del Coronado. Led by chef Jojo Ruiz, this seaside eatery boasts an expansive seafood menu so enticing that choosing just one dish feels impossible. For a fine dining experience, indulge in Seréa's caviar service, featuring sturgeon caviar paired with creme fraiche and finely diced shallots, or keep it classic with the fresh-caught, wood-grilled fish. sereasandiego.com

RUSTIC ROOT

The recently opened Rustic Root in Solana Beach offers a welcoming atmosphere that feels both familiar and sophisticated. On its spacious patio, the outdoor fire pits, string lights and eclectic seating make for a comfortable experience from daytime until late at night. While the menu has many highlights, the 28-day aged ribeye is a must-try, made with a rich cabernet reduction and a pristinely layered potato gratin. rusticrootsd.com

OCEANA COASTAL KITCHEN

Oceana Coastal Kitchen, a mainstay inside the Catamaran Resort Hotel, provides beautiful views of the Mission Bay when dining on its outdoor patio. EMBER & RYE

Celebrity chef Richard Blais' North County steakhouse, Ember & Rye, is a hit thanks to its gourmet steaks, which are wood-fired on the patio that overlooks the Park Hyatt Aviara golf course. Whether dining in the sun during

Mille Fleurs transports diners to the French countryside in the heart of charming Rancho Santa Fe.
