- You will need to **include a resume** with your application.
- You will need **one letter of recommendation**. If you have not asked anyone for a recommendation, you can request one with a teacher, counselor, coach, pastor, organization sponsor, or supervisor, using our recommendation request form found in the document folder in Family Connection.
- If the scholarship you are applying for requires an **additional essay question**, please type on a separate piece of paper and include it with your application. Include your name and the name of the scholarship at the top of your essay page.
- **Your scholarship will not be considered if it is not signed.** If you are under the age of 18 please make sure your parents sign the application as well.
- This scholarship is in a fillable form. Only typed applications will be accepted.

Application packets will need to be turned into the scholarship office by 3:30 PM on November 28th. No applications will be accepted after that point. If you have any questions please see or email Mrs. Bradley or Mrs. Hadaway.
