

## **Membership Covenant**

Having been led, as we believe, by the Spirit of God,<sup>1</sup> to embrace Jesus as the Lord,<sup>2</sup> Savior,<sup>3</sup> and supreme Treasure of our lives,<sup>4</sup> and having been baptized in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,<sup>5</sup> we do now, in the presence of God,<sup>6</sup> angels,<sup>7</sup> and this assembly, most solemnly and joyfully enter into covenant with one another as one body in Christ.<sup>8</sup>

We engage, therefore, by the aid of the Spirit, <sup>9</sup> to walk together in Christian love, <sup>10</sup> to strive for the advancement of this church <sup>11</sup> in knowledge, <sup>12</sup> holiness, <sup>13</sup> and peace; <sup>14</sup> to promote its spirituality and fruitfulness; <sup>15</sup> and to sustain its worship, <sup>16</sup> ordinances, <sup>17</sup> and discipline. <sup>18</sup>

We likewise engage, to uphold the Table Rock Member Affirmation of Faith; to welcome, test biblically, and apply instruction from the Scriptures by the Elders of the church which accords with the Table Rock Elder Affirmation of Faith; <sup>19</sup> to contribute cheerfully <sup>20</sup> and regularly <sup>21</sup> to the support of the ministry, <sup>22</sup> the expenses of this church, <sup>23</sup> the relief of the poor, <sup>24</sup> and the spread of the gospel in this city and among all the nations. <sup>25</sup> We also engage to maintain family <sup>26</sup> and personal devotions; <sup>27</sup> to seek the salvation of our friends, family, and neighbors; <sup>28</sup> to educate our children in the Christian faith; <sup>29</sup> to walk wisely in the world; <sup>30</sup> to be just in our dealings, <sup>31</sup> faithful in our engagements, <sup>32</sup> and exemplary in our conduct, <sup>33</sup> and to avoid all gossip, <sup>34</sup> slander, <sup>35</sup> excessive anger, <sup>36</sup> drunkenness, <sup>37</sup> and sexual sin. <sup>38</sup>

We further engage to watch over one another in brotherly love;<sup>39</sup> to remember one another in prayer;<sup>40</sup> to aid one another in sickness and distress;<sup>41</sup> to cultivate Christian sympathy in feeling<sup>42</sup> and courtesy in speech;<sup>43</sup> to be slow to take offense,<sup>44</sup> but always ready for reconciliation,<sup>45</sup> and mindful of the rules of our Savior to secure it without delay.<sup>46</sup>

We moreover engage that when we remove from this place, we will notify the church leaders, and, if possible, unite with a like-minded church where we can carry out the spirit of this covenant.<sup>47</sup>
