Yet nearly 90% of the food Iowans eat is imported, resulting in valuable food dollars leaving our state every day and making us vulnerable to food supply chain disruptions. We also experience inequitable access to healthy food, diet related health issues, and declining rural communities. These dynamics are not sustainable, but neither are they inevitable.

With the Iowa Food System Plan, we envision a better way.

Securing and developing resources to support a local and regional food system as an essential part of Iowa agriculture.



Using policy change and food system innovation to build and sustain the health and wellbeing of Iowans.
