

Our weekly schedule allows our studentathletes to study and train like professionals from Monday to Friday, with the additional option to remain in education for a third year to attain a **Personal Training qualification (NCFE Level 3 Diploma in Gym Instructing & Personal** Training).



We run a minibus shuttle service on Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays - collecting our students from Bletchley and Central Milton Keynes station in the morning, transporting them to the Academy at Tattenhoe, and then dropping them back to the stations at the end of the day.

# EDUCATION

### COURSES

OPTION 1

At Varsity Nine Academy, we want our student-athletes to succeed on the pitch and in the classroom. Therefore from their very first day at the academy, we emphasise that education is of paramount importance to football.

Depending on an incoming student's academic level they have various course options for the year. Students will study towards, and gain a qualification equivalent to either 2 or 3 A-Levels:

OPTION 2

NCFE Level 3 in Sport and Physical Activity Pathway Option: Sport & Exercise Science or Sports Coaching

YEAR 1 - NCFE LEVEL 3 CERTIFICATE - 6 UNITS YEAR 2 - NCFE LEVEL 3 DIPLOMA (720) - 6 UNITS

YEAR 1 - NCFE LEVEL 3 DIPLOMA (540) - 9 UNITS YEAR 2 - NCFE LEVEL 3 EXTENDED DIPLOMA - 9 UNITS

### OPTIONAL YEAR 3 COURSE: NCFE LEVEL 3 DIPLOMA IN GYM INSTRUCTING AND PERSONAL TRAINING

This qualification provides learners with the knowledge, understanding and practical skills needed to work as a Gym Instructor and Personal Trainer in a variety of settings. Learners who achieve this qualification could progress into employment or self-employment as a Gym Instructor or Personal Trainer. It is internally assessed with an external quality-assured portfolio of evidence.

After each completed year, a certificate is mailed to the student's home address.

We ensure the student-to-teacher ratio is around 20:1, so we know each student is receiving the best support possible.

The course is 100% coursework, with no exams. Education assessment is a combination of both theory and practical work e.g. coaching and practical instruction. There will be continuous ongoing assessment/assignment completion throughout the course to develop a portfolio of evidence.

Different types of assessment include:

- Practical
- Roleplay
- Group work
- Written report
- Video and verbal presentations

Students are given time and support to complete assignments, with tutors providing extensive feedback from improvements prior to final submission. Microsoft 365 is provided to all students, so students will only need to bring a laptop, notebook & pen, and a positive attitude to their education sessions.

### Requirements

We look for students with at least 5 GCSEs at a level 4 or above. We are fortunate enough to offer a Diploma course as well as the Extended Diploma qualifications, therefore, we can be selective with who we enrol as long as we feel we are not setting a student up for failure and adequate support can be provided for the individual in question.

#### Math & English

For students who do not achieve a grade 4 in Math & English Language, they are entitled to free GCSE resists each year they are enrolled on our programme. Students who achieved a grade 3 will resit in November, whereas students who achieved a 2 or below will resit the following May/June. Functional skills and entry level exams are also available.

Weekly Math & English sessions are timetabled for applicable students.

# ACADEMY COSTS



#### **Academy Uniform**

It is a mandatory requirement for all students to purchase, and wear, Varsity Nine uniform whilst on site and when representing the academy. You can view this year's collection <u>here</u>.

#### **Tours and Experience Days**

Parents and students are given several months notice ahead of these events and we also offer payment plan options.

#### Laptops

Students are asked to have a laptop as the majority of assignments are required to be submitted online. The academy uses Microsoft 365, which is provided to all students free of charge. We also help students who do not have access to a personal laptop via a loan scheme, which is free.

#### **Registration Fee**

We charge a registration fee of £350 ahead of the start of each academic year. The fee secures a student's place on the course, and also contributes to the enrichment content of the Varsity Nine programme; physio clinics, gym sessions, transportation to and from away games, strength and conditioning, video analysis and exclusive academy pre-season training sessions and fixtures leading up to induction week in September. The fee is only refundable if we are unable to enrol you on the programme.

#### **Bursaries**

The 16-19 Bursary Fund provides financial support to help learners overcome specific barriers to participation, and to ensure that they can remain in education. All students are able to apply for a bursary if their household income is below the designated threshold. If your application is successful, you will receive a termly allowance which can be used for food, travel, uniform and equipment to support your education. At Varsity Nine Academy we remind our students to apply for their bursary in August, prior to induction week. Once term commences, we prompt any students who haven't already applied to make their application as soon as possible. More information about the Bursary Fund can be found <u>here</u>.

We run these events every half term at our Milton Keynes facility.
