Why High-Capacity Transit?

The Moving Forward Chesapeake 2035 Comprehensive Plan and 2050 Master Transportation Plan have recognized a need to provide a multimodal transportation system to support regional mobility and accessibility for Chesapeake residents. Improving connections between Chesapeake and the greater Hampton Roads area reduces auto-dependency, enhances access to key destinations, and provides a sustainable and cost-effective transportation alternative to the automobile.

High-capacity transit is a form of public transit that typically operates in its own lane or right-of-way. These vehicles generally make fewer stops, travel at higher speeds, have more frequent service, and carry more people than local transit service.

Connecting more people faster, farther, and more efficiently.

The study will evaluate the need for high-capacity transit service and determine the best alternative that improves connections within Chesapeake and to the greater Hampton Roads area, as well as supports the City's economy and growth plans.

At the conclusion of this study a report will be prepared that outlines the study process and identifies high-capacity transit alignments and technology options that can be carried forward into future phases of analysis.

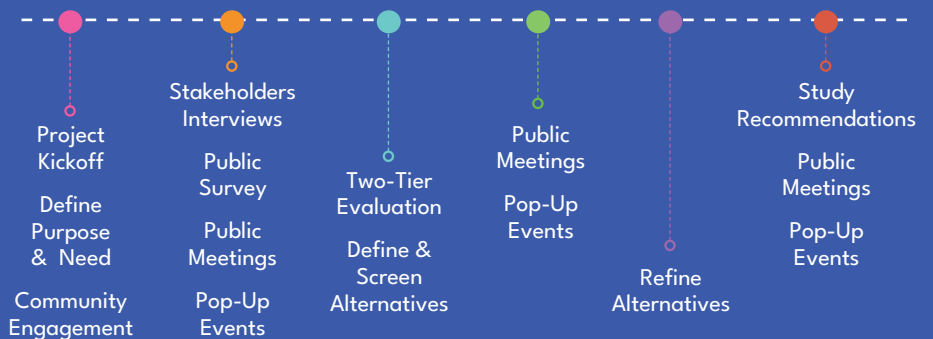

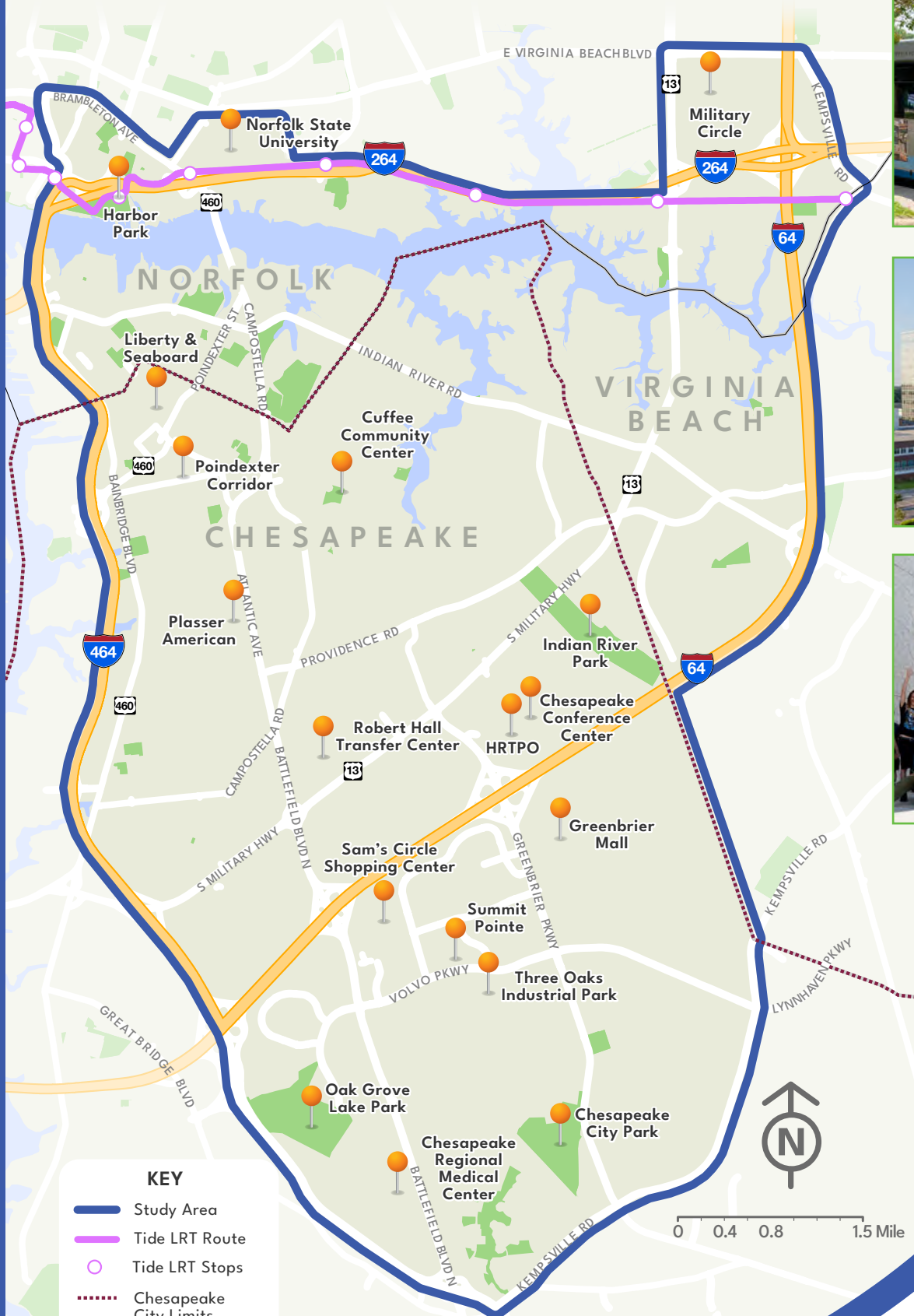

Study Schedule

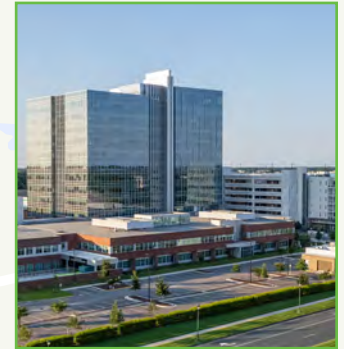
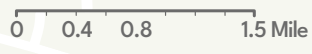


Study Area
