



A STUDY OF HIGH-CAPACITY TRANSIT

PROJECT UPDATE SUMMER 2024

It's time to connect our city.

Hampton Roads Transit (HRT) and the City of Chesapeake have teamed up to explore high-capacity transit options that enhance the City's economy, align with future growth plans and improve connectivity to the regional transportation network.



Purpose & Need Fall 2023

Working with the

HRT developed the
Purpose and Need
statement that defined
goals, objectives and
criteria to evaluate
alternatives that support
regional connectivity
and economic growth.



Tier 1 Evaluation Winter 2023

The Tier 1 Evaluation defined 16 alignment alternatives that connect destinations and align with the City's needs and growth plans. The alternatives were measured and scored against the goals, objectives and criteria, and four alignment alternatives were selected for further review.



Tier 2 Evaluation Summer 2024

Guided by input from the City and Chesapeake communities, HRT is currently evaluating the four alignment alternatives identified to be carried forward into the Tier 2 analysis, exploring environmental benefits and impacts, planning-level capital and operating costs, ridership and types of high-capacity transit.



Recommendation Winter 2025

The study will recommend up to two alternatives to City Council for more detailed review and analysis.



Tier 2 Evaluation Process










Tier 2 Alignment Alternatives
