## white

glass - carafe

125 375 btl

7 - 19- 35

### Sov'Ran

Kent, England - yup, thats right. 100% Ortega (a variety that hales from Germany), honeysuckle and citrus peel on the nose followed by tropical notes on the palate. \*S \*V

### Le Bon Côté

5.5 - 14.5 - 25

Languedoc, France - white blend of Vermentino, local grape Terret and a dash of Viognier for texture, gently pressed and cool fermented to give a crisp fruity wine. \*S

### "METAMORPHIKA"

7 - 19 - 35

Catalonia, Spain - From vines 60 and 110 years old. A little funky in comparison to your average Chenin Blanc. Based on minerality rather than in fruitiness. In-fact it has a nice saltiness plus a bit of smokiness and some citrusy notes like lime. \*O \*N

## rosé

### Pasaeli Calkarasi

7.5 - 21 - 34

Cal-Denzli, Turkey - 100% Calkarasi. Single vineyard, aged on lees (dead yeast) for three months for a more full-bodied rosé. Notes of strawberry and raspberries. \*S

### Ollieux Romanis

4 - 10 - 18

Languedoc, France - From one of the oldest vines in the region. Pale pink, dry with aromas of red summer fruits, delicious! \*O



## sparkling

### 47 AD Prosecco

6 - - - 28

Vento, Italy - 100% Glera. Soft apple, peach and grapefruit flavours with crisp and refreshing citrus in a delicately bubbly, 'frizzante' style. \*O \*V

### Jean Paul Deville

11 - - - 49

Champagne, France - Pinot Noir, Chardonnay. Nose of apples, pears and straw, filling out in the mouth to reveal nice strawberry fruit and finishing with crisp hazelnut and citrus notes. \*S

## red

### Eschenhof Holzer

6 - 15.5 - 26

Wagram, Austria - This Zweigelt is ripe with gently spicy summer berry and red cherry fruit. Plenty of mouth-watering acidity with hints of black pepper. \*O\*V

### William Downie "Cathedral"

11 - 31 - 54

Australia, Victoria - defined Pinot, with dark red berries, soft spice, fresh acidity and a lick of forest floor earthiness. Fruit is 70% from Mornington Peninsula with the rest from King Valley. \*S

### De Kleine Wijn Koöp

9.5 - 26 - 43

South Africa, Stellenbosch - low-yielding Cinsault bushvines,.Soft, smooth with an earthy nose. Well balanced and delightful. \*O\*V

Swartland, South Africa - A pretty nose with notes of flowers, herbs and ginger before lemon and orange aromas develop. Palate has fruit, citrus and minerals to go with bright acidity. Light and energetic. \*O
