This event will take place at Malcolm X College Conference Center from 10am-5pm and invite the audience to "choose their own adventure" through the space: visit the Secret Garden on the rooftop for dance therapy or experience sound, movement, or poetry workshops on the ground floor. The day will feature life-size pinatas, interactive puppets, chair yoga, mural art making, screen printing, panel discussions, healthy food vendors representing the City of Chicago, and more. Workshops will be led by artists-in-residence at the City's mental health clinics, who have also earned their community health worker certification at Malcolm X demonstrating ways creative workers can be powerful members of the wellness workforce while infusing health and wellness into their art.

Headliners include Grammy-nominated singer and songwriter John Forté featuring Binta, poet, writer and lyricist Aja monet and Grammynominated hip-hop artist Vic Mensa.

HARLAN COUNTY, KY

HAWAI'I ISLAND, HI

Join us for our island-wide block party! On July 27th, Vibrant Hawai'i art fellows are exhibiting the culmination of their year-long work in 11 artistic showcases held across Hawai'i Island. These 11 artist fellows will present visual arts, natural fiber weavings, devised theater, music performances and workshops in kapa, community-created quilting, writing, and more. Showcase locations include Waimea, Kapa'au, Kailua-Kona, Holualoa, Kealakekua (Kainaliu-town), Ka'awaloa, Hilo, Pāhoa, Mountain View, and Volcano. Events begin at 7 am and take place throughout the day until 10 pm.

HONOLULU, HI



O'ahu welcomes all to Thomas Square in Honolulu, the site of the restoration of Hawai'i's sovereignty in 1843, as part of an outdoor celebration surrounding Lā Ho'iho'i Ea or Sovereignty Restoration Day. This day will celebrate community-created works rooted in place and created in real time. Hands-on activities with organic mediums, including lauhala (pandanus), 'ohe (bamboo), and niu (coconut), will be shared, as well as exhibitions of photography and multimedia works. Also included will be breaking workshops, performances, and the telling of mo'olelo (stories). This outdoor celebration and hands-on event takes place on July 27th from 10am to 3pm.



KANSAS CITY, MO

Art as Mentorship, founded by the band Making Movies, will host Celebrate AMERI'KANA, a music and arts festival bringing together national, local, and youth performers in a celebration of the diverse origins and colors of American music. The festival features Rubén Albarrán of the Mexican rock band Café Tacvba, Justus West, youth performers from Rebel Song Academy, and more from the vibrant Kansas City arts community.. This festival will take place on July 27th at The Concourse Park from 1 pm to 8pm and also features Mercado, an international open-air market showcasing local artists, creators, growers, and small businesses, local food trucks, and a bouncy house for kids.

OAKLAND, CA
