

REP. BOEBERT ALIGNS WITH ANTIFA TRIES TO CANCEL STEVE BANNON APPEARANCE

CD 4 Rep. Lauren Boebert – overcome by Dave Derangement Syndrome or Middle School Mean Girl Disorder – aligned herself with the efforts of Antifa and tried to convince Steve Bannon to cancel his appearance as keynote speaker at the CO GOP's Centennial Dinner last weekend.

Fortunately, the enormously popular War Room host saw through Boebert's disgraceful move and appeared as scheduled to deliver a passionate speech rallying MAGA supporters in Colorado.

The annual Centennial Dinner is one of the State Party's biggest fundraisers and landing Bannon as the keynote speaker ensured its success. Bannon saw through Boebert's pathetic move and insiders say folks in Washington, DC are starting to wonder what's going on with her antics.

The Bannon cancel effort was not Boebert's only outrageous behavior at the CO GOP reorganization meeting. She brutally played CO GOP Chair candidate Darcy Schoening by promising to support her and deliver her nomination speech. But at the last minute, Boebert backed out in an effort to humiliate Schoening and hurt her campaign. Boebert then made it clear she was supporting the UniParty/Establishment RINO candidate, Brita Horn.
