Once \$1,600/\$3,200 IRS Minimum is met, you have no out-of-pocket costs

## Surgical Bundle

### Includes:

- Pre-Op Consultation
- Facility Fee
- Physician Fee
- Anesthesia Fee
- Implants when used (varies based on bundle)
- Post-Op Appointment (varies based on bundle)

### Excludes:

- Lab Work
- DME
- Imaging
- Pathology (varies based on bundle)
- Physical Therapy (varies based on bundle)
- Home Health

*\*If excluded from the bundle, in most scenarios, we can facilitate this as well. However, it will have to be a separate referral.*

**Tip: If it is not listed on the voucher issued to the member, it is not a part of the bundle.**

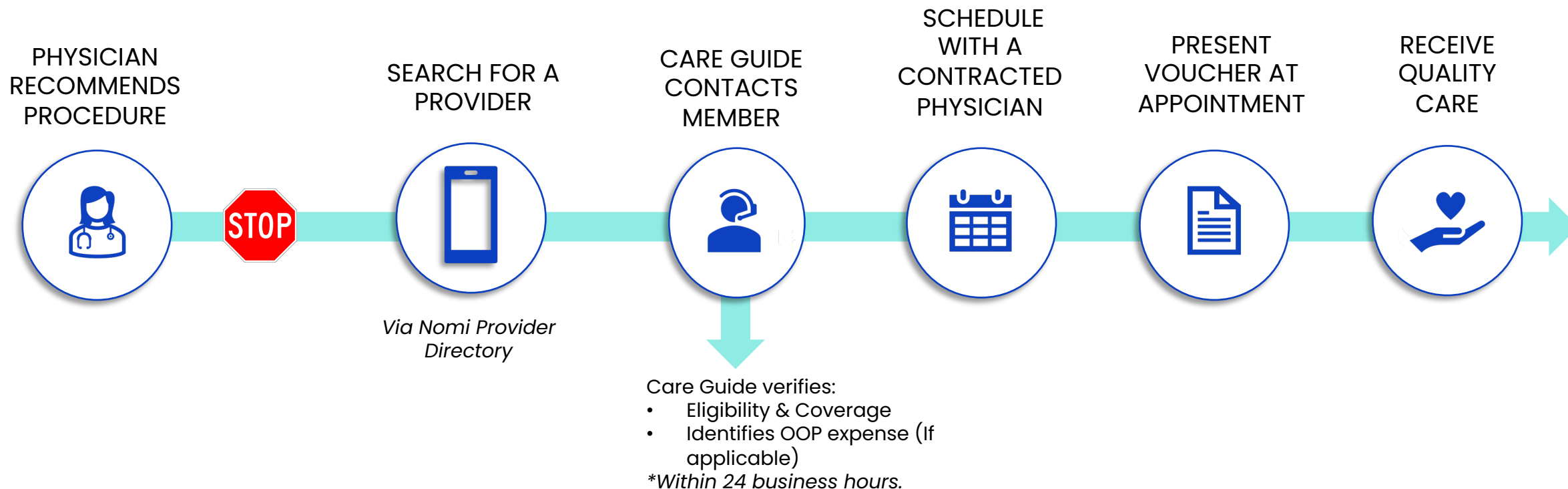

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
