Referral Options

To access our diabetes education services, you can self-refer by using the referral form on our website or, see your GP for a referral.

- If you are eligible for a care plan and your GP decides that you would benefit from seeing a Diabetes Educator, you may be allocated up to five visits that will be partially Medicare funded.
- If your GP has referred you to the Integrated Chronic Disease Care funded program, your diabetes education will be fully funded.
