12,500 Hot Farm Tractors

- 1. Weight 12,500 lb weight limit
- 2. Speed 12 mph max speed limit
 - a. When the digital speed board is in use, anything over 12 mph will be disqualified.
 - When no digital speed board is in use, any blowing of speed horn after the 100 ft mark will be disqualified.
 - c. First puller/test pull is allowed to drop the hook even if they break the RPM or speed rule, but must come back last in running order.
 - d. If the puller exceeds 12 MPH they can finish their pull if they choose to.
- 3. Tires 20.8 non-cut tires, this is the MAX size
 - a. Radial or bias tire allowed
 - b. Top cut tires allowed
 - c. No full cut or double cuts of any kind
 - d. No lug/bar can be altered
 - e. No duals allowed
 - f. All tractors must be 2WD, NO 4WD tractors allowed
- **4. RPM** 3000 RPM max no splices or alterations in wires, must have proper sensor in place, 100 RPM tolerance
 - a. All tractors must be equipped with ISS Pro Part #019R8906
 - b. Cord must be single molded 14-16 gauge cord from sensor to rear of tractor, with 110V female plug end
 - c. Cord must be continuous; only splice allowed is at the sensor.
 - d. Each tractor is allowed 1 no read per season.
- **5. Fuel** DIESEL FUEL ONLY, will be checked by cup test cup must withstand fuel minimal of 4 minutes no nitrous or propane allowed.
 - a. Random fuel checks can be done at any time per tech official discretion.
- 6. Throttle All tractors must have working deadman throttle.
- 7. Air Shut Off All tractors must have an air shut off "guillotine" must be working and it MUST be spring loaded.
- 8. Cage All tractors are required to have a cab, roll bar, or roll cage.
- **9. Wheelie Bars** Wheelie bars are mandatory for all tractors.
 - a. Design and material used must withstand the impact of sled and must support the weight of the tractor.
 - b. Skid pads on wheelie bars cannot be more than 10 inches from ground.
 - c. Skid pads must be minimum of 5"x5"
 - d. No wheels on wheelie bars.
- **10. Safety Belts** All tractors are required to have safety belts, a lap belt is the minimum requirement and it MUST be worn.
- 11. Exhaust Exhaust must be straight pipes, NO curved pipes. All tractors must have cross bolts in the exhaust there must be two (2) % inch Grade 8 bolts in the horizontal part of the exhaust ½ inch apart bolts must be welded in
- **12. Frame** All tractors to remain stock appearance and stock frame.
 - a. All tractors must have fenders that must be able to support the weight of the driver.
 - b. All tractors must have 0.060 thick floor boards.
 - c. Side shields are recommended but not mandatory.
- 13. Hitch Maximum hitch is 20 inch must be rigid in all directions before, during, and after pull
- **14. Helmet** All pullers are required to wear a helmet and it must be strapped.
- 15. Fire Extinguisher All tractors must have a working fire extinguisher

- **16. Fenders** All tractors must have fenders that are capable of supporting the weight of the driver.
- **17. Neutral Start** Every tractor must have a neutral safety switch tractors CANNOT start in gear tractors must have a neutral safety light in working order
- **18. Clutch** Clutch blankets are recommended, but are not mandatory.
- 19. Fans All fans must be shrouded.
- 20. Brakes All tractors must have working brakes.
- **21. RPM Read** Each tractor is allowed one (1) no RPM read per season, every no RPM read after that will result in a disqualification.
- 22. Rules All tractors and drivers must comply with all general and safety rules.
- **23. Points** Tractor must be a member in order to receive points. There will be points paid out at the awards banquet at the end of the season.
- **24. Payout** 1st \$300, 2nd \$200, 3rd \$150, 4th \$100, 5th \$100, 6th \$50, 7th \$50, 8th \$50 Total purse payout \$1000
- **25. 2024 Season** This class is a trial class for the 2024 season. Members will not have a vote at the general meeting. Members must make 70% of the pulls for this class in order to have voting rights in this class.
- **All safety rules can be adjusted if needed. Since this class is new, adjustments to rules may be made as seen necessary by officials.
