Billing Process

Students coming from *sending institutions*;

Your campus will be billed for your CMC participation 6 weeks prior to the start of your semester.

In turn, campuses bill their students following the campus' established policies and procedures.

To retain your loans, you must remain enrolled at your home institution or another higher education institution that can process your loans.

For more information on the process of applying your student loans to an off-campus program, contact your home institution's financial aid office and ask about their process and requirements.

EXPENSES COVERED BY CMC FEES:

- 16 hours of academic credit
- Housing in gated apartment
- Fully furnished apartment
- Wifi in each apartment
- Access to swimming pool and fitness center
- Washing machines are available at no extra cost
- Community meals (approx. one each week)
- Travel, meals and accommodations for practicum (Road Tour)
- 24/7 use of over a million dollar rehearsal and recording facilities

ADDITIONAL ANTICIPATED EXPENSES:

- Travel between home and the program
- \$50 housing security/damages deposit (due upon arrival; refundable following post-departure inspection)
- Health insurance, valid for entire length of stay/program dates
- Meals (approx. \$80/week)
- Personal discretionary expenditures (recommend \$300-\$500), including local transportation
- Personal medical expenses, if incurred

If you are coming independent of a sending institution, you will be **billed directly** for your CMC participation 6 weeks prior to the start of your semester.

You will receive an email to set up your student account with step by step instructions for creating a payment plan.

Your Semester Charges have been loaded into your Student Account Dashboard and are available to view by logging in to my.Greenville. Once logged in, select Students, My Financials, then click the blue "Pay Using Nelnet" button to enter your Student Account Dashboard. If someone else is responsible for paying your bill, make sure you grant them permission/access to your Dashboard, by adding them as an Authorized Party.

Once logged in, you can view your Semester Charges, as well as make payments, or set up/manage a monthly payment plan.
