Gering won't seek second Chelan County commissioner term

WENATCHEE — Chelan County Commissioner Tiffany Gering told NCWLIFE today she will not run again to represent the county's Third District.

Gering, a Chelan Republican, was elected to the seat in 2020. One of the candidates she defeated for the open position announced this morning that he'll run for the post a second time.





Brandt Cappell

Brandt Cappell is a Wenatchee Republican and senior legislative assistant to 12th District State Rep. Keith Goehner. The county's District 3 runs from north Wenatchee to include Sunnyslope, Entiat, Chelan and Manson.

So far Cappell is the only person to file for the office with the Washington Public Disclosure Commission. In District 1, incumbent Chelan County Commissioner Kevin Overbay of Malaga has filed to seek reelection to a third term in November. The District 2 seat, held by Shon Smith, will not be up for election until 2026.

The final week for candidates to register is May 5 through May 10.
