Poster & Abstract Guidelines

We happily accept poster and abstract submissions for the Plexus Skills conference. Posters offer an excellent opportunity to share your research and case studies with colleagues and peers. Both posters and abstracts must be submitted to the Plexus Evaluation Committee (pr@medx.hr) by **October 1st**. All submissions will be reviewed, and decisions will be communicated to authors. Formatting Guidelines

- Use readable font sizes (24-28 pt for title, 18-22 pt for body text)
- Clear sections (**Introduction, Methods, Results, Discussion, Conclusion**)
- High-quality graphics, figures, and images
- Logical flow and consistent style/color scheme
- Print on large format for 1-2 meter visibility (e.g. A0)
- An abstract of the poster needs to be provided (up to **350 words**) and will be included in the **abstract book** which will be indexed
- Posters will be displayed in or next to the main conference hall during part of the one-day conference
- Participants are responsible for printing their posters as well as fitting them on poster boards
- For those travelling, feel free to reach out to pr@medx.hr so we can suggest local print shops

Poster guidelines

- **Submission Types Accepted:** original research, case reports, review articles
- **Topic:** basic research and clinical topics accepted; topics has to have a **medical aspect** (topics without a medical aspect (e.g. chemistry, physics topics with no medical connection) will not be accepted.
- **Authorship Limit:** One person can be the primary author on a maximum of one poster, but can be an author on two additional posters

Abstract Guidelines

The abstract should summarize the essential aspects of the study. Clear and objective language should be used to outline the purpose, methods, key results, and main conclusions of the research. There is no option to present abstracts live at the conference - only poster presentations will occur during the event. Abstracts will be included in an indexed **abstract book**.

- **Word Limit:** 350 words
- **Topic:** basic research and clinical topics accepted; topics has to have a medical aspect (topics without a medical aspect (e.g. chemistry, physics topics with no medical connection) will not be accepted.
- **Structure:** Background, Methods, Results, Conclusions, Keywords, References (up to 5)
- Do not use abbreviations unless defined
- No figures or tables allowed
