
## 2 DAYS 1 NIGHT CHARTER

### COSTA PALMAS TO ISLA CERRALVO

Isla Cerralvo, whose official name is Isla Jacques Cousteau, has underwater topography and currents that attract enormous amounts of marine life. Virtually all local marine life must migrate past the island, and the water is clear to 30 meters, making it a prime location for both snorkeling and big game fishing. There are abundant golden grouper, marlin, sailfish, swordfish, broadbill and others.

Isla Cerralvo is located off the Cerralvo Canal coast, and is the ninth-largest island in Mexico—18 miles in length, with a land area of 136,498 square kilometres.

You'll embark on your yacht in the morning and



enjoy a gentle cruise north towards the island, spending the day exploring land and sea. Views from the island at sunset are brilliantly colorful, the perfect backdrop for an on-board cocktail. Your chef on board will prepare a wonderful dinner and you'll fall asleep at anchor. The following day, after a leisurely breakfast, you will calmly cruise back to Costa Palmas.

## 4 DAYS 3 NIGHT CHARTER

The Sea of Cortez is so rich in life, landscapes and islands to explore that a single day and night will leave you wanting more. Taking time at sea opens vast new horizons, allowing you and your family to take a deep dive—literally

and figuratively—into the incomparable natural world around us.

### DAY 1: COSTA PALMAS TO BALANDRA COVE

Depart in the morning from Costa Palmas in the company of pods of playful dolphins, and cruise towards the beautiful bay of Balandra Cove. The afternoon is for water play with kayaks, paddleboards, jet skis and more in the shallow, crystal-clear waters. Enjoy your sunset on board the yacht whilst cruising to the stunning Baja California Bay and keep an eye out for the El Hongo de Balandra—the Mushroom of Balandra—a unique rock structure shaped by thousands of years of erosion. After dinner you'll end the evening in the best possible way: stargazing at sea.

### DAY 2: BALANDRA COVE TO ISLA ESPIRITU SANTO

Watch the scenery unfold as we cruise Bahia San Gabriel to the uninhabited Isla Espiritu Santo, a UNESCO Natural Protected Area and World Heritage Site with an astounding biodiversity of endemic flora, fauna, marine life and archaeological remains. Head ashore over aquamarine waters by tender or kayak and stroll white-sand beaches, a stark contrast to the island's vibrant red, pink, and brown volcanic rocks. To the north, Punta Prieta offers sublime snorkeling, and hiking fans will follow the trail from the beach to Playa Bonanza.

### DAY 3: ESPIRITU SANTO TO ISLA PARTIDA

At sunrise, we'll head to the enchanting Isla Partida, dropping anchor in the turquoise waters on the northern tip of Ensenada Grande. Sea lions will be frolicking at the nearby Los Islotes Islands while you enjoy breakfast aboard. You can tender over to swim amongst the sea lion pups: an unforgettable experience. Isla Partida reefs await for sun-dappled snorkeling and on the island you can visit caves and explore beaches famed for turtle nests. There's excellent fishing and action at Marisla

Seamount, a few miles away, or you can dive with manta rays and schools of hammerhead sharks.

### DAY 4: ISLA PARTIDA TO ISLA SAN FRANCISCO

We'll cruise to Half Moon Bay and the uninhabited Isla San Francisco, once the home of gold miners and pearl prospectors. Today, a different gold—yellowtail surgeonfish—can be discovered while snorkeling the area's rocky reefs. The perfect day for sunbathing on deck, enjoying the yacht's tenders and toys and paddleboarding to the beach. In the late afternoon we'll cruise home to Costa Palmas whilst enjoying the sunset.
