Stalls and RVs will be reserved online with a credit card. Credit Cards are not be charged in advance.

STALLS (MUST be reserved): \$115 - All 3 nights if reserved by July 5th, after July 5th stalls \$135. NO REFUNDS AFTER JULY 12th, 2024 Midland County Fairgrounds requires that ALL horses have a stall.

<u>**Iump Out Fee**</u> (includes stall, one day only, no overnight stay): **\$50** pre-reserved ONLY, as available.

MOVE-IN: after 11:00 am Thursday, 7/25.

Credit Cards will be accepted for stalls, RV or entries - 4% convenience fee. - Negative Coggins (within 12 months) required.
- **AQHA Rookie Class Eligibility Requirements**: Exhibitor cannot have earned more than <u>10 Lifetime points</u> in that class. Horse cannot have earned more than <u>50 Lifetime points</u> in that class. Exhibitor must have a current AQHA membership or can purchase at the show. Exhibitor does not have to own the registered quarter horse.
- MQHA Small Fry Exhibitors 12 & under (as of January 1), all classes walk /trot only.
 - o Small Fry Eligibility: If a Small Fry exhibitor earns one of the following at a recognized breed show, they will not be eligible to participate in any MQHA Small Fry classes, with the exception of Halter & Showmanship:
 - 1. Earning at least ½ breed point in a three gaited class.
 - 2. Winning a Circuit Championship at any recognized breed show in a three gaited class. 3. Winning a High Point Champion in a three gaited division at any recognized breed show. Entries must show AQHA registration papers showing current owner (copy of a transfer does not count) and individual AQHA membership card. *Properly fitted ASTM/SEI approved helmet for all Lead Line and Small Fry exhibitors in all riding events.
- Lead Line Participants in Lead Line will be assisted by a handler that must be 18 years of age or older. These exhibitors can be placed at the discretion of the show management. *Properly fitted ASTM/SEI approved helmet required all Lead Line & Small Fry exhibitors in all riding events.
- AWARDS: Ribbons for 1st through 6th place. Prizes for all 1st place winners.
- **HIGH POINT AWARDS**: Small Fry, Rookie Youth, Level 1/Novice Youth 13 & under, Level 1/Novice Youth 14-18, All Age Youth, Rookie Amateur, Level 1/Novice Amateur, Select Amateur, Amateur & Open
 - o *Exhibitors must show in corresponding halter or performance halter class to be eligible for HP*
 - *Exhibitors must show in at least three events per division to be eligible*
