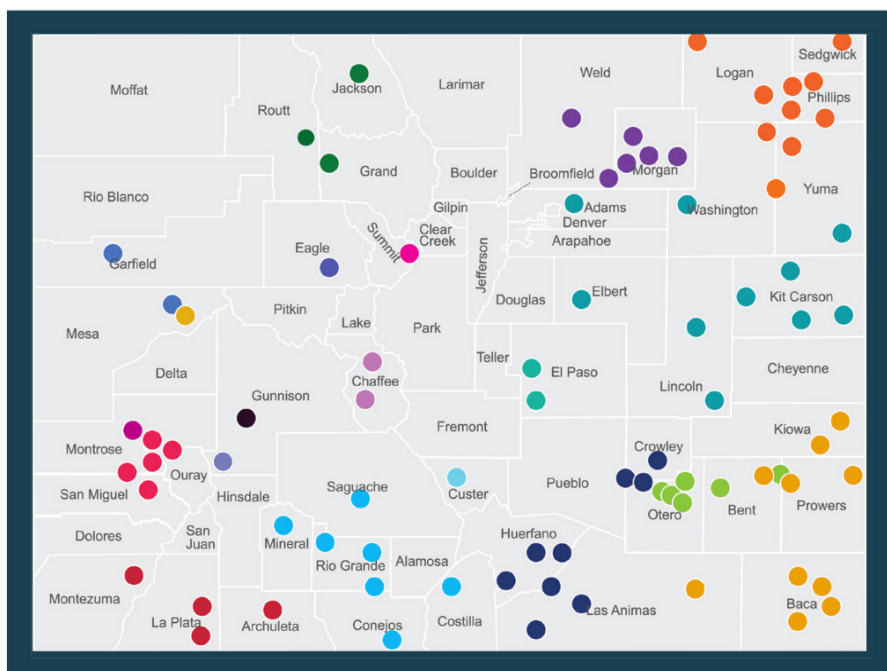

## FOCUS AREA

### College & Career Readiness

## RECENT PROGRESS

- Secured a **Rural Coaction Grant** for the I-76 College and Career Readiness pathways work which helps to support rural districts plan and develop programs to expand learning opportunities to strengthen student engagement in learning-both during the traditional school and beyond.
- Secured funding, including a **RISE grant** from Governor Polis's Office, to support ongoing efforts to collaboratively construct and facilitate a shared college/career pathway across the six districts of the Santa Fe Trail (SFT) BOCES as a successful rural exemplar. More [here](#).
- Supported the SFT BOCES districts working with community members to determine three essential skills which will serve as a "North Star" to guide the development and expansion of the Pathway to Prosperity program and ensure that students are equipped with the skills needed to be successful after graduation.
- Identified **Marzano Research** as partner for building teaching, practice, and demonstration of **North Star Skills** into the Pathway to Prosperity.
- Duplicated the Pathway to Prosperity initiative in the [I-76 Corridor](#) and [Spanish Peaks](#) regions.
- Organized a regional entrepreneurship fair which has included over 250+ students since 2022.
- Awarded a Catalyze Challenge Grant (15 awardees out of 850+ applicants) to expand the entrepreneurship fair to special populations across CO.
- Developed and implemented CDE Graduation Guideline capstones at different four school districts.

### Social Emotional Learning & Students At-Risk

- Secured and supported **Expelled & At-Risk Student Services Grants (EARSS)** to serve the 15% of students struggling the most in South Central (SC) and San Luis Valley (SLV) BOCES school districts as well as Weld Re-3 (Keensburg).
- Secured and supported **Creating Healthy Schools Grants** for Primero, Kit Carson, Weld Re-3 (Keensburg), Huerfano, and West End.
- Secured and supported **Bullying Prevention Grants** in SC BOCES districts.
- Assisted Huerfano, Las Animas, and Primero in securing **School Counselor Corps Grants**.
- Secured funds to provide **daily Social Emotional Learning (SEL)** for students in 19 rural districts. [Third-party research](#) demonstrated improvements in all SEL competencies and significant impact on student academic success, giving the program an expanded evidence base.
- Implemented **Education Stability Grants** in Wiggins School District and Hanover School District which allowed both districts to hire a full-time Advocate to support students who are migrant, homeless, or navigating the foster care system.
- Launched **monthly SEL Forums**. See past forums [here](#).

### Student-Centered Accountability & Reporting

- Created the **Student-Centered Reporting Solution (SCRS)** - a homegrown technology solution serving 24 school districts across Colorado by bringing together education leaders, researchers, policy makers, technology funders and programmers to remove persistent barriers to addressing equity in education.
- Supported Northeast (NE) BOCES districts in enabling the use of an **assessment tool** that has value to key stakeholders and creating dashboard reports that will allow stakeholders to see the success of the school systems. More [here](#).
- Received funding from the **Michael & Susan Dell Foundation** to create a [Student-Centered Accountability Program](#) (S-CAP) dashboard.
  - › Provided partnership and support for **S-CAP** to realize its vision over a five-year period and then function effectively on its own.
  - › Represented S-CAP in the national **Hewlett Deeper Learning Network**.
  - › Grew participating districts to 15.

## FOCUS AREA

## RECENT PROGRESS

### Teacher Leader Efficacy

- Secured support for Aguilar, Huerfano, Ignacio, Bennett, Monte Vista, East Otero, Montrose, Las Animas, Wiggins, and Morgan County to participate in **CDE approved Turnaround Leadership Program** providing graduate certificates (**CSU-Global**) and articulation into principal licensure programming.
- Executed a **principal induction program** that meets CDE's updated requirements for SC BOCES and provided **20 scholarships** for a diverse group of principals to complete the program and receive professional licensure.
- Supported Aguilar, Bennett and East Otero and in securing **Connect for Success Grants** which offer teachers the opportunity to observe instruction at high-performing schools and work with a school improvement coach.
- Supported securing school improvement grants (Pathways) for Aguilar, Huerfano, and Monte Vista and (District Led) grants for Aguilar and Otis.

### STEM

- Secured and supported evaluation of 21st Century Learning Grants, which include computer coding opportunities for students, for Cañon City and Wiggins School Districts.
- Secured a Computer Science Grant for the SFT BOCES to allow for teacher training in computer coding and student engagement in coding.
- Partnered with LearningBlade to provide STEM quests to rural students at no charge.

### Teacher Recruitment & Retention

- Secured and supported implementation of **CDE Teacher Retention Grants** for East Central (EC), NE, and SLV BOCES enabling math teachers to receive **scholarships for master's degrees** and participate in a professional learning community. Higher Education Partners: **CSU-Global Campus** (coursework), **Western State Colorado University**, and **University of Denver** (PLCs)
- Secured and supported implementation of **CDE Teacher Retention Grants** for Southeastern (SE) and SFT BOCES enabling teachers to acquire **SPED credentials** and participate in a professional learning community. Higher Education Partner: **Western State Colorado University**
- Partnered with the University of Denver, SE & SFT BOCES to secure a **Plan Into Action Grant** that prepared potential school counselors for a rural immersion experience to ensure students have support needed to positively participate in the classroom, lessening teacher burden.
- Secured funding for and supported two **Teacher Immersion Experiences** in spring 2018 (La Veta & SFT BOCES) based on the initial effort in 2016 and 2017 that saw **33% of candidates placed**.
- [Job board](#) with nearly 1,000 visitors each month and new postings added weekly to the CREC website as a collaborative effort to bring teachers into the rural communities of Colorado.
- Secured funding for 11 SFT BOCES teachers to **complete Master's Degrees or dual enrollment certificates**, enabling the districts to **increase concurrent enrollment offerings by more than 50%**. Report: [Concurrent Enrollment Increase](#)
- Secured funding for and supported SC BOCES districts in implementation of a **Math/Science Partnership and Math Mentors grant** to advance math teacher efficacy, recruitment and retention which demonstrated a **90% retention rate**. [More here](#).

### COVID-19 Response

- Secured funding from The **Governor's COVID-19 Relief Fund** managed by **Mile High United Way** for requests from Weld Re-3 (community emergency fund), Sierra Grande (technology), and GSN (*Coping with Crisis* curricular units and PD, Preventing Summer Learning Loss training sessions and COVID-19 Response Scenario Series for rural districts).
- **Created Coping with Crisis SEL Units for EL, MS and HS** in response to the pandemic.
- Facilitated **monthly rural superintendent forums** to support joint problem-solving during the pandemic.
