TIMEFRAME	WHAT TO DO
Junior year: fall semester	<ul> <li>Start brainstorming your college list</li> <li>Prep for the SAT/ACT</li> </ul>
Junior year: spring semester	<ul> <li>Top priority: keep those grades high!</li> <li>Begin visiting colleges</li> <li>Take the SAT or ACT</li> <li>Start researching scholarships, costs, and financial aid</li> <li>Ask two teachers for recommendations</li> </ul>
Summer before senior year	<ul> <li>Create a list of schools you want to apply to, including potential EA/ED schools</li> <li>Write your résumé</li> <li>Ask 1 or 2 people to be on your committee</li> <li>Start writing your essays in July or early August</li> <li>By Labor Day, complete the Common App personal essay and supplemental essays for one school</li> </ul>
Senior year: fall semester	<ul> <li>Finish writing your supplemental essays</li> <li>Finalize your EA/ED list and RD list</li> <li>Fill out the FAFSA and CSS Profile</li> <li>Apply for admission, financial aid, and scholarships!</li> </ul>
Senior year: spring semester	<ul> <li>Watch for admissions decisions from schools</li> <li>Review your offers and pick a school</li> <li>Relax and enjoy senior spring; just be sure to keep your grades up (a college can rescind its offer if your grades tank!)</li> </ul>
