Americans have been begging for railroad expansion, and this is the chance for the Federal Rail Administration to do the right thing. We need reliable high speed railways that prioritizes network connectivity and does not put freight service above riders. Good public transportation is integrated with other local transit services in physical location, operational coordination, and quality customer experience. Passengers being able to take a train is great but passengers being confident about routes, timing, pricing, and safety is critical.
