Maggie Braun was born in 1985 in Muskoka, Canada and spent her early life in Papua New Guinea. She pursued her studies in ecosystem management and later became a political activist by running for the Canadian Action Party (CAP) in 2011. Maggie spent the next 12 years as a homeschooling parent, community volunteer, and board member of the CAP and Terrace Green Thumb Society.

During the COVID pandemic, she attended the Freedom Convoy of Hope and was arrested for her peaceful protest. Later, Maggie testified at the Public Order Emergency Commission, believing that Canada's democratic systems were not functioning properly.

While speaking in communities across Canada Maggie realized the need for a citizen led organization to bring about systematic change through civic engagement. Gather2030 was born and now leads the KICLEI Initiative - a project designed to help Canadians engage their municipalities, protect their community and strengthen citizen led democracy.
