
# OUR FAVORITE TRIP TO JACKSON HOLE — THROUGH YELLOWSTONE!

Full Map from Bozeman, Montana to Jackson Hole, Wyoming


2 or 3 Nights – 3 Days (can be done quicker)

Fly Into Bozeman, Montana – Rent a car and drive 50 minutes to Chico Hot Springs Resort & Day Spa for a relaxing evening.

## **Things To Do:**

- Stop in the cute little town of Livingston for lunch
- Hike, nap, and relax at Chico Hot Springs before your days in Yellowstone
- Soak in the hot springs day/night, or our favorite, over a cup of coffee first thing in the morning before heading into Yellowstone!
- Eat dinner at the famous Historic Dining Room (on site). Farm to Table GREAT eats and wine! (Need reservations)
- Night cap with live music at your first of many Honky-Tonks, The Saloon (on site)


#### **Recommendations:**

- Request a cabin for private bathrooms, or a private room inside the hotel which DOES NOT have shared bathrooms. Feeling adventurous, sleep in a wagon glamping camp!
- No A/C needed or provided at hotel. Warm during the day, cool at night. Windows open at sunset will make the room plenty chilly!



#### **Recommendations:**


- Yellowstone National Park is NOT known for its food. Eat at the following places below
  - Breakfast at Chico Hot Springs Hotel
  - Lunch and the last opportunity for quality meal before entering the park is in Gardiner, Montana. <u>Wonderland Café & Lodge</u> is a great place to grab a burger or quality meal and coffee
- Speed limit inside Yellowstone is 25-40 MPH
- If you're waiting in traffic lines for parking at Yellowstone's pull-over areas, stay in line and be patient. The traffic usually moves quickly, and it's much better than having to hike longer distances to reach the sights
- Make dinner reservations at Lake Yellowstone Hotel. You can enjoy cocktails and appetizers before dinner in the hotel lobby while listening to the string quartet
- Lake Yellowstone Hotel has the nicest accommodations out of all the hotels in the park (and it's not that fancy). Our second recommendation is Canyon Lodge & Cabins with food courts




# DAY 3, MAP 1: OLD FAITHFUL AND/OR GRAND TETON NATIONAL PARK TO JACKSON HOLE

Stay in the park for another night, or pass right through to Jackson Hole


