NUESTROS PROGRAMAS EN ESPAÑOL

El Consejo de Seguridad contra Incendios del Condado de Mendocino tiene muchos programas gratuitos para los residentes del Condado de Mendocino. Para más información y para solicitarlos en español, visite firesafemendocino.org/espanol.

Asistencia para Crear un Espacio Seguro: Gratis para personas mayores y personas con discapacidad. Le ayuda a tener un espacio contra incendios de 100 pies alrededor de su casa.

Días de Triturar Ramas con un "chipper": Únase a sus vecinos para crear montones de ramas y nuestro equipo las triturará para usted sin costo alguno.

Evaluaciones de Viviendas: Hechas por un profesional, las inspecciones son gratuitas y le mostrarán (sin obligación) cómo proteger su casa contra los incendios forestales.

Cree un Consejo de Seguridad contra Incendios o una Comunidad Firewise: Junto a sus vecinos y con nuestro apoyo pueden organizarse y obtener recursos para mejorar su preparación contra incendios.

Letreros de Dirección Reflectantes: Cuestan \$20 dólares y se pueden ver a través del humo y por la noche; así será más fácil localizar su casa en caso de incendio.

Micro Ayudas: Hay subvenciones para ayudarlo a preparar su comunidad en caso de incendios forestales.

Trabajo Comunitario: Organice un evento comunitario para juntos reducir los materiales combustible en su barrio.

DEFENSIBLE SPACE ASSISTANCE FOR INCOME-ELIGIBLE (DSAFIE)

This program helps low-income seniors and people with physical disabilities meet the 100-foot defensible-space requirements. DSAFIE services can include tree-trimming, brush-cutting, leaf-raking, chipping, weed-whacking, gutter-clearing, or moving wood piles.



WILDFIRE RISK HOME ASSESSMENTS

We provide free wildfire-risk Home Assessments for 3-4 homes in the same area on the same day. A trained professional walks your property with you and provides non-judgemental, non-binding recommendations to make your home safer from wildfire, and identifying priority steps for the best possible protection.

REFLECTIVE ADDRESS SIGNS

These address signs help emergency responders find you even if it is dark or smoky. We offer custom reflective address signs to county residents for \$20. We ask that all signs be picked up in Ukiah. However, if a larger order is placed by a neighborhood group, other arrangements can be discussed.



COMMUNITY CHIPPER DAYS

This free program requires multiple residents in an area to request a Chipper Day: you schedule a day with our staff, and shortly before that day make brush piles that meet our guidelines. Our crew will come and chip the brush that you and your neighbors have cleared from your defensible spaces. Chipper Days reduce the cost of maintaining defensible space. Please see our website for guidelines on making brush piles that our crew can chip.



NEIGHBORHOOD FIRE SAFE COUNCIL (NFSC)

NFSCs are the foundation of fire preparedness in our communities. They get neighbors talking and planning for work projects, Chipper Days or Micro-Grants; they can organize local alert systems, map fire hazards, work with their fire department on evacuation routes, or identify large projects that require grant funding and coordination.



FIREWISE COMMUNITY

Firewise USA® offers national recognition as a Firewise Community – a greater level of neighborhood coordination and preparedness than NFSCs – by providing a process for taking action to minimize wildfire risks. Firewise status benefits the whole community by stimulating action toward common goals, making the whole community much safer from fire, and possibly qualifying you for insurance discounts. If your neighborhood is ready, our staff will help you every step of the way.
