A Program for High School Juniors **Application Deadline – Tuesday, September 23, 2025**

ELIGIBILITY

Junior Leadership Wayne County is open to all Juniors who attend public, private, or parochial schools located in Wayne County. Interested students should:

- Have a solid "B" or above average.
- Possess positive social skills.
- Be involved in school and/or community activities.
- Have a desire to learn more about Wayne County.
- Be willing to commit to 100% participation.
- Have good moral character.

SELECTION PROCESS

Phase One: Application

Interested students must complete an application. All fields of the application are required and must be received by the application deadline. Junior Leadership Committee members will complete a blind review of the application and rate it on a designated scale. Each applicant must have a minimum of 2 completed reference forms and must receive a recommendation from their school counselor or career counselor. Applicant's personal information will not be considered during this review. Selected applicants will be invited to participate in Phase Two of the selection process.

Phase Two: Discovery Day

Selected applicants from Phase One will be invited to participate in a one-day event held from 8:00 am – 2:00 pm at The Maxwell Center and will include opportunities for students to learn more about their leadership style, participate in team building activities, communicate with community leaders, and focus on various topics related to leadership. Applicants will be evaluated and scored throughout the day by committee members. Selected applicants will be invited to participate in the full 8-month Junior Leadership program. Applicants will be notified by email of their status in the selection process.

PROGRAM CALENDAR

The Junior Leadership program will meet for nine full-day sessions from October through May. Participation in all events is required, as well as working on project assignments outside of official program days. To fulfill graduation requirements, students can miss no more than eight hours and must attend and participate in Discovery Day. Students must make appropriate arrangements with teachers for any missed work. Parents are invited to attend the graduation.
