PI17001 Agrisilica® pilot study – John Steemson

- Ratoon crop performance
 - Host Littabella Pines
 - Established May 2021
 - Broadcast application, rotary hoe incorporation, beds formed
 - 0, 400, 800, 1200kg/ha rates
 - Nematode populations lower at 10 & 18 months post plant
 - Increased ratoon yield
 - Supply issues since August 2023 due to Charters Towers mine flooded
