1. **GEORGIA CADET LEADERSHIP COURSE (GaCLC) ANNOUNCEMENT.** We are pleased to announce that registration is now open for the Georgia Cadet Leadership Course (GaCLC), which will be held at Georgia Military College in Milledgeville, Georgia. This letter aims to provide parents and Cadets with essential information about the camp and its expectations.

- a) Overview: GaCLC is summer activities and STEM-based leadership development camp for AFJROTC Cadets from <u>Monday</u>, June 9 through mid-day Saturday, June 14, for what promises to be a memorable experience. Your Cadet must let us know by <u>Friday</u>, 28 February if they are attending.
- b) Participants: Over 200 Cadets from Air Force JROTC programs around the state will attend to include Cleveland, Etowah, Greene Co, Monroe Area, Northgate, Northside, Ola, Sequoyah, Troup Co, Twiggs Co, Veterans, Washington Co, Westside, and, Wheeler.

2. **DUES AND FORMS.** Cadets participating in GaCLC will pay an activity fee of **\$300 dollars** which is due by **Wednesday, 15 April** in Parent Vue or by check made out to "AFJROTC CLC".

- a) Activity Fee: This fee covers some of the transportation, room, and board for the camp. Considering the average cost for a week of overnight summer camp in the United States is \$1,256, this camp offers significant value.
- b) Required Forms: Also due before any Cadets can participate is a signed WAIVER, INSURANCE, MEDIA AND CONSENT FORMs. Cadets without these forms on file will not be allowed to participate.
- 3. **SCHEDULE.** Student drop-off at Baugh Barracks is on Monday between 0900 and 1100. Parents are encouraged to return to GMC for graduation by 0900 on Saturday; graduation will begin at 1000 after which Cadets will be released.
 - a) Transportation: We will also have a school bus to transport students to and from the camp on Monday and Saturday.
 - b) Activities: Student will spend a total of 120 hours participating in activities designed to test, to strain, and most importantly, to grow.

- 4. **PROGRAM EXPECTATIONS.** Since this is the first year, our goal is to establish baseline interest in the program by each Cadet performing the following:
 - a. Physical Fitness: Each Cadet must be able to run one mile in under 11 minutes for girls (15 sit-ups/15 push-up) and under 10 minutes for boys (30 sit-ups/30 pushups), and score at least in the 50th percentile on the AFJROTC physical fitness test by 2 April.
 - b. Completing GaCLC demonstrates a Cadet's dedication to becoming better, faster, and stronger and signifies their commitment to taking on larger leadership roles within the Corps of Cadets.

We are excited to support your Cadet as they embark on the next step of their personal development journey.

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
