- 1. **OVERVIEW/ENTRY PERIOD:** The Sweepstakes starts on January 1, 2025, at 7:00 A.M. ET, and ends on February 2, 2025, at 11:59 P.M. ET (the "Sweepstakes Period"). One (1) Grand Prize winner will be selected at the closing of the Sweepstakes Period. Crayola's computer shall be the official Sweepstakes Period clock.
- 2. **ELIGIBILITY:** This Sweepstakes is offered only to permanent, legal residents of the United States who are 18 years of age or older at the time of entry.
